## Dear Parents/Caregivers

I write to confirm the diocesan primary school Attendance Dues and Catholic Special Character Contribution rate for 2024 and provide a brief explanation of these items:

Attendance Dues	<b>\$430.00</b> (plus GST) <b>per annum</b> (\$107.50 plus GST, per term)
<b>Catholic Special Character Contribution</b>	<b>\$60.00 per annum</b> (\$15.00 per term)

## **Attendance Dues**

Attendance Dues are a legal charge and not a donation. Attendance Dues are for property related costs, including compliance costs, school building works, loan repayments, building insurance and costs directly associated with the administration of attendance dues.

## **Catholic Special Character Contribution**

The Catholic Special Character Contribution (CSCC) is a voluntary contribution. As such it is exempt from GST and is tax deductible; a 33% refund can be claimed from the IRD.

## No contributions are made by the Government for attendance dues matters or CSCC services.

If you are experiencing hardship (loss of income/redundancy, family reasons, etc.) and need some financial support you are encouraged to approach your parish priest to discuss your circumstances.
