THE DIFFERENT VOCATIONS IN LIFE

The Church teaches that there are three vocations in life: single, married and priesthood or religious life.

Firstly, the Catechism of the Church (CCC#1658) says that there are a great number of people who remain single not by their choosing but possibly by life circumstances, so let us be mindful of them, help them and know that they are a part of God's family.

Secondly, marriage is the most popular of these three vocations. It is a covenant by which a man and a woman establish between themselves a partnership for life, and which is ordered by its nature to the food of the spouses and the procreation and education of offspring and has been raised by Christ to the dignity of a Sacrament. It is a lifelong commitment of unity and oneness of mind and body that is why Jesus reminds them in today's gospel that what God has united, man must not divide. There are many challenges facing marriage at this modern time so to keep them one all the time praying, following God's plan, and supporting community are absolutely necessary.

Finally, priesthood and religious life is another calling by God to serve Him and the Church through the reception of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC#1547) states, the priest serves the faithful by building up and guiding the Church in the name of Jesus Christ, who is head of the body. A priest makes a lifelong promise of celibacy and obedience to a bishop or religious superior and dedicate his life in the service of God's people. Let us pray for more vocations to priesthood and religious life in our Diocese of Christchurch. Whatever state of life we are in right now, let us thank the Lord our God, be faithful and always be open to His will.

This week begins the school holiday. Let us keep in our prayers our children in our four schools that they may be safe and may they enjoy the times with their families.


