# THE LORD COMES QUICKLY TO VISIT US PERSONALLY

We are on the last Sunday of Advent. Christmas is near and the birthday of the Saviour which we have been waiting for is at our door. The Church invites us to give the final touch to our preparations to receive the Lord who is about to come.

In the Gospel today we read about the visitation of Mary, where Mary travels to the hill country of Judah to visit her cousin Elizabeth. The visit of Mary to Elizabeth was not a mere coincidence. It was a well thought out plan of God.

This season, God has planned to honour each one of us personally with a divine visit. This visit is not by accident. Rather, it is a well-planned visit. He knows the way to where we live, he knows our house number, he knows the number of our flat, and he knows exactly the number of our room. He comes quickly to visit us personally in order to bring about some remarkable changes in our lives.

This season, we are about to have a divine visitation and encounter with the child Jesus. This encounter will fill us with the Holy Spirit who will empower us as he empowered Elizabeth. This divine encounter with Christ will bring us transformation and it will provoke peace and greater joy in our hearts as it did for Elizabeth and the child in her womb. Soon we shall hear a knock at our door, and hear the voice of Mary bearing the divine child. They are close to us.

On this last weekend of Advent, God calls us into action as Mary did. Mary visited Elizabeth and shared that she was carrying Jesus in

her womb. Sharing Jesus with others is the best gift we can give. Let us take time to visit others this Christmas, to bring some inspiration into their lives, and hopefully to bring them closer to God, who is Love.

### **JUBILEE YEAR 2025**

In 2025, the Diocese will join the global Catholic Church in celebrating a Jubilee Year — a centuries-old tradition dedicated to promoting renewal, spiritual growth, mercy and forgiveness.

Pope Francis has chosen the theme "Pilgrims of Hope" for the Jubilee. He encourages us to deepen our faith through pilgrimage, prayer, the sacrament of Reconciliation and works of mercy during the Jubilee year.

There are many universal celebrations for the Jubilee, including the opening of the Holy Doors at St Peter's Basilica in Rome, alongside many other celebrations in the 2025 calendar. Here in the Diocese, the Jubilee Year will open on Sunday 26 January, with Bishop Michael celebrating the 9.30am Mass at St Mary's Pro-Cathedral.

Pilgrimages are an important element of the Jubilee Year where individuals, parishes and groups are invited to visit as part of the Jubilee celebrations. A number of pilgrimage sites have been designated in the Diocese.
