

THE MYSTERY OF GOD'S LOVE

The Holy Trinity is a profound mystery of our faith: Three Persons in One God. Sometimes, our minds become entangled in curiosity or confusion as we try to use logic and evidence to "solve" the mystery of the Triune God – as though it were a problem to be figured out. But on this Solemnity of the Most

Holy Trinity, rather than getting stuck in intellectual explanations, let us contemplate God's inner life and identity, which is LOVE.

Saint John the Apostle offers a simple yet complete definition of God: "God is Love" (1 John 4:8). God is a Family, a Community of Love. Within this community, there are three relationships: the Father is the Lover, Jesus is the one who is Loved, and the Holy Spirit is the very act of Loving.

Because of His boundless love, God the Father created us in His image and gave us life. Jesus the Son offered Himself on the Cross to redeem us from our sins and bring us salvation. The Holy Spirit now sanctifies us, renews us, and guides us into all truth.

The mystery of the Trinity is not distant - it is alive and present in our daily lives. Everything God does is out of love for us. And He invites us to imitate Him: to live in love, to receive love, and to become instruments of love in the world.

Whenever we genuinely love one another, we make the life of the Holy Trinity visible. So from the beginning to the end of each day, in all that we think, say, or do, let us do it out of love – and do it "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" Amen.


