## TRUE DISCIPLESHIP

In today's Gospel (Luke 14:25-33), Jesus speaks very directly about what it means to be His disciple. He tells the crowd that following Him requires giving up everything and taking up the cross each day. His words sound demanding, even unsettling, but they remind us that discipleship cannot be half-hearted. It is not about staying close to Jesus only when it is easy or convenient. True discipleship is a total commitment – remaining with Him always, even when the road becomes difficult.

A disciple is someone who follows the Master for life, striving to live like the Master in all things. For this reason, the disciple must see Jesus as the only model and the one to love above all. That is why the disciple must be ready to renounce everything — not only family ties but even one's own self with personal desires and ambitions. Only then can the disciple follow Jesus, learning to speak like Him, think like Him, and love like Him.

To be a Christian is to carry Christ within us. For Christ to truly dwell in our hearts, we must clear away what does not belong to Him: selfishness, pride, resentment, sinful habits, and attachments that keep us from loving fully. The daily cross is not always a great burden; often it is the small but steady effort to forgive rather than hold a grudge, to choose patience over anger, to serve without expecting reward, and to always choose love. These small crosses slowly shape us in Christ's likeness.

True discipleship is demanding, but it leads to deep freedom. When we let go of what holds us back and allow Christ to be at the centre, He transforms us from within. Then, through our words and actions, we can reflect His presence to the world and discover the lasting joy and peace of following Him.

Performances from our four parish schools and Cathedral College.


Followed by a shared lunch including a sausage sizzle.
