## PREPARING A WAY FOR THE LORD

In the First Reading, Isaiah reassures us that even when everything appears cut down—like the family tree of Jesse reduced to a stump—God brings new life. From that stump, a new shoot will spring: a king filled with the Spirit, rich with the virtues of his ancestors, and a champion of the poor who will restore

The Second Reading continues this theme. St Paul reminds the Romans that Jesus is the one through whom God fulfils His promises and brings harmony, unity, and hope.

In the Gospel, Matthew introduces John the Baptist as the herald foretold by Isaiah. John's voice calls us once again to "prepare the way of the Lord"—not just in history, but in our lives today.

Advent is a season of renewal. It invites us to pause, to look honestly at where we are, and to open our hearts to what God desires to do now. Advent leads us toward hope—hope not as passive waiting, but as a confidence that God is at work in our lives. Hope strengthens our spirit just as prayer nourishes our soul and bread sustains our bodies.

This season offers each of us a fresh opportunity to commit ourselves to Jesus Christ and His Kingdom.

May this Advent be holy and blessed for all the families of our parish, Stella Maris.
