PUT JOSEPH INTO THE ADVENT SEASON AS A GREAT MODEL TO IMITATE.

The season of Advent is not about our preparation to receive Jesus. It is about allowing God to prepare and change us according to his plan to meet Jesus who comes on our way in various ways.

Today's first reading and the gospel talks about how God has prepared his chosen people to celebrate the first Christmas. The preparation was begun 700 years before the birth of his son Jesus with the prophesy of Prophet Isaiah.

God chose few people and prepared them for the Incarnation to take place.

They were Joachim and Anna, Elizabeth and Zachariah, and Mary and Joseph.

Today, we focus on Joseph. The gospel today narrates the role of Joseph.

Joseph does not speak one single word in the scriptures and yet he had a crucial role in the great mystery of the incarnation. Joseph was an honest man, and he had his own dreams about his life. All his dreams about his life are shattered when he found that that his wife is pregnant. Joseph was troubled, confused, and lost.

God in turn blesses him with a dream in which he reveals his plan. Joseph agrees to cooperate with God's plan by bringing Mary home in marriage. He adjusted his own dreams, hopes, desires and plan to save the people from their sins.

Like Joseph, we too find our life shattered due to sickness, unemployment, misunderstanding, loneliness, and confusion. One day we will realise as if in a dream that everything happened with a reason and it was to prepare us for a greater good.

Let us put Joseph into the Advent season as great model to imitate and allow God to prepare and change us as per his plan.
