THE SECRET OF TRUE HAPPINESS

Everyone wants to be happy. We work hard, make plans, save money, and look for comfort and security. Yet even with all this, happiness often feels temporary. In this Sunday's gospel, Jesus addresses this deep longing for happiness by offering the Beatitudes. He teaches that real happiness is not found in success, but in **surrender** to God.

A Heart Open to God

True happiness begins with a heart that knows it needs God. The poor in spirit rely on His strength more than their own. Those who mourn are not afraid to bring their pain to Him, and in this honesty, they find His comfort. The meek do not push or dominate; their calm trust in God becomes their strength. Happiness grows when we stop pretending to be in control and allow God to lead.

A Heart Hungry for Goodness

Those who hunger and thirst for righteousness want to live with integrity and grace. Their hearts are pure — not perfect, but sincere. Because of this, they notice God's presence in daily life. Their happiness comes from desiring what God desires.

A Heart That Shares God's Love

Merciful people forgive quickly and carry light hearts. They are peacemakers who build understanding rather than walls. Wherever mercy and peace are practiced, joy naturally follows, because love always creates space for happiness.

Jesus shows that happiness does not begin with perfect circumstances, but with a heart open to God. When we trust Him, forgive others, live simply, and work for peace, we discover a joy that the world cannot take away. This is the true happiness Jesus wants for us.
