FUNDAMENTAL OPTION FOR LIFE AND HAPPINESS

Today many people don't want to hear about 'dos and don'ts'. In the name of freedom and 'freedom of expression' in particular, many people want to do things the way they feel it is 'good'.

On the other hand, many people are careful in following the 'dos and don'ts' in the manuals of their expensive phones, TVs, cars, etc. Why? Because they don't want to damage their phones, TVs, cars, health etc.

Similarly, because God doesn't want us to destroy the precious life He has given us, He gives us His commandments ('dos and don'ts') to follow.

As the dos and don'ts of a good parent are not meant to make life unbearable for the child, but to enable the child to attain a better life in the future, so according to the first reading, God's commandments are not to make life unbearable, but to give us life instead of death (Sirach 15:15-20).

God, in His wisdom and based on His dream for our future, has given us dos and don'ts to enable us achieve life and not death; indeed, to attain eternal life in heaven and not eternal death. God makes it clear that whatever choice we make in life has its consequences.

Today, the church invites us to reflect on the law of Christ and urges us to pay attention to what she teaches us. The law of Christ is a divine law. However, it is not opposed to natural law. It is a product of God's love for us. It is filled with wisdom and gives life to those who are faithful to it. Hence, to obey it, is a fundamental option for life and happiness.
